SUPERINTENDING ENGINEER (STRUCTURAL) - ONE (1) POSITION - ADVERT NO. 17/2024/01

Basic Salary Scale: Kshs. 50,610 - 67,110 p.mCPSB 07(Job Group 'M')Allowances as per SRC Circulars attached to the positionTerms of service: Three (3) year contract
